Licensing

Our new licensing model makes it convenient to acquire Atlas 2.8 either on an annual basis or with attractive multi-year contracts. We can help you find the model that works best for your budget. All Atlas bundles are priced on a per-controller basis (except in HA configurations where we do not require an additional license for the standby controller).

Unlimited Capacity

Another way we're trying to disrupt the storage industry is to eliminate "gotcha" pricing when customers want to expand their capacity. We find that upcharging for software when a customer simply wants to grow capacity and accommodate more content is unnecessary. With our new 2024 model, all bundles comes with unlimited capacity per controller, meaning you can add another 500 TB or even 2 PB without additional software fees.
